Primitive/RV camping is allowed (no hookups or facilities).

Awards will be given through third place in AMA classes 401 (Sportsman), 402 (Intermediate), 403 (Advanced), 404 (Masters) and 405 (FAI). Any AMA legal aircraft is allowed in Sportsman Class. Noise check will be waived in all classes. FAI Class will fly the P-09 sequence in all contest rounds.

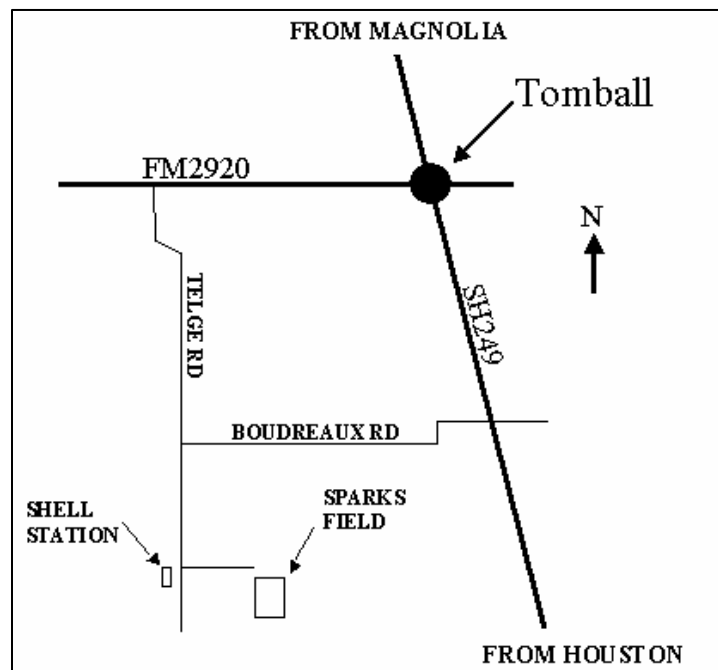
